Paratransit is a curb-to-curb demand response service provided to disabled and elderly citizens. Starkville-MSU Area Rapid Transit (SMART) is proud to be an ADA Paratransit service, required by Federal Law, which SMART provides for disabled riders. ADA service eligibility and certification is required in order to utilize the service. The applications must be filled out completely and legibly. The Physician's verification of Disability Form must be completed by a doctor, licensed health care provider, or licensed rehab/social worker familiar with your disability. You can download these forms on our website at www. smart.msstate.edu.

Once SMART receives your completed application, you may be contacted to schedule an in-person interview to aid in the determination of your eligibility. You can mail it to PO Box 6350, Mississippi State, MS 39762. Upon request, transportation will be provided to you free of charge, both to and from the interview site.

You will receive a determination letter within 21 days. If you require any assistance in completing this application, you may call our office at (662) 325-7594.
